Cancellation of Rally of Tsumagoi 2020

Jyoshu Auto Club (JAC) has applied Rally of Tsumagoi 2020(6th - 9th February 2020) for a round of FIA Asia-Pacific Rally Championship and JAF Japanese Rally Championship. However, Tsumagoi village where the rally is held was suffered catastrophic damages from the typhoon No.19 (recognised typhoon Hagibis internationally).

Many places in the village were flooded and national road route 114, the life line road for the village was taken by water in places.

On the 11th of November, The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT) and the village council have decided to convert Panorama North line and Panorama Aisainooka line into detour road of route 114 as an emergency measure until the original route 114 has been fixed.

As a result, the rally will loose huge percentages of special stages and not possible to archive the necessary stage mileage for the Asia-Pacific Rally Championship and Japanese Rally Championship without those two roads. Therefore JAC has decided to cancel the rally.

JAC will proceed the process of the cancellation.
